GECPS

- **What is [GECPS](#)?**

GECPS is a standardized and secure method to report GA Reportable Violation Codes to DDS according to HB1253.

- **[GECPS Online Account](#)**

The online account allows GECPS users to update contact information, review outstanding errors and access documents uploaded by DDS.

ERROR HIGHLIGHTS

2063 Error Description: Failed to locate the violation using the information provided.

Solution: Check the Violation Code, or Georgia Reportable Offenses to DDS List. Code may be entered incorrectly or code is a non-reportable offense to DDS.

The following example may cause this error code:

Example 1: Court submits a conviction for Controlled Substance violation code 16132B violation date 02/01/2016 these offenses are no longer reportable to DDS based on legislative updates for 2015, if the offense date is on or after July 1st, 2015 don't report.. Please don't report any controlled substance offenses to DDS unless offense date was prior to July 1st, 2015. If the controlled substance offense occurred on or after July 1st, 2015 only report if the conviction was a felony in the commission of which a motor vehicle was used.
