

## Determining DUI Consequences as of July 1, 2008

- 10 year window applies to the criminal case and includes the following:
  - Length of sentence
  - Mandatory confinement
  - Fine
  - Community service
  - \* Clinical evaluations should be included in all sentences, but can be waived by the court only for a 1<sup>st</sup> DUI within ten (10) years
  
- 5 year window applies to the license suspension and related collateral consequences:
  - Period of license suspension or revocation
  - Eligibility for a limited driving permit
  - Surrender of license plate
  - Photo publication requirement
  - Ignition interlock requirement
  - Printing of red stripe on driver's license
  - \* DDS will require all customers to provide proof of completion of a DUI Drug or Alcohol Use Risk Reduction Program as a pre-requisite for reinstatement
  - \* For incidents occurring on or after July 1, 2008, DDS will only require customers to provide proof of completion of a clinical evaluation (and treatment, if recommended) for reinstatement of a driver's license suspension or revocation for a second or subsequent DUI within ten (10) years
