New Federal Certification Requirements

Federal Rules require Commercial Drivers subject to the physical qualification requirements of the FMCSA to provide a copy of the Medical Examiner's Certificate to the Department of Driver Services (DDS) by January 30, 2014.


- The information will be maintained on your State driving record.
- Your certification information will be available to Law Enforcement or Regulatory Agencies.

Drivers will need to take the following steps:

- Complete the Self-certification process which will document what type of commerce you operate in and the medical certification requirement.
- Provide Medical Certificate ... (If Required)
 - The Customer is required to maintain a valid Medical Certificate on record with DDS at all times.
 - The Customer should continue to keep their Medical Certificate/DOT Card with them at all times.
- Provide variance documentation (if applicable)
 - Must be provided in addition to the Medical Certificate and must remain valid.

Failure to take action will result in:

- Notification will be sent to driver advising that they no longer meet medical qualifications
- DDS will cancel all CDL privileges
- You must provide and maintain a valid medical certificate or your CDL privileges will be cancelled.
- If you require a variance you must provide and maintain a valid variance or your CDL privileges will be cancelled.
