Alternative Resources for Background Investigations

In the event the Department is unable to obtain classifiable electronically recorded fingerprints from an applicant for reasons that are beyond the applicant's control, the Department may conduct a background investigation of such applicant utilizing the CJIS Name Search procedures authorized by the Federal Bureau of Investigations and the Georgia Bureau of Investigations.

SYNOPSIS

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE AND MAIN FEATURES OF PROPOSED RULE

The purpose of this proposed amendment is to modify an existing regulation in light of changes in the governing statutes, specifically the changes made by House Bill 269 enacted at the 2011 Session of the Georgia General Assembly, which authorized an alternative background investigation if fingerprints are not available.

DIFFERENCES BETWEEN EXISTING AND PROPOSED RULES

This is a new regulation.
