**Suspension, or Revocation, or Cancellation of Chauffeur's Permit Endorsement.**

(1) A chauffeur's ~~permit~~ endorsement may be suspended if the bearer is charged with, and may be revoked if the bearer is convicted of, any of the offenses listed in O.C.G.A. §46-7-85.10(3)(A).

(2) A chauffeur's ~~permit~~ endorsement may be suspended or revoked if it is found that the bearer gave false information on his or her application.

(3) The Department may at any time, after notice and opportunity to be heard, suspend or revoke any chauffeur ~~permit~~ endorsement, if it shall be made to appear that the holder has willfully violated the rules and regulations prescribed by the Department.

(4) If the Georgia driver's license of the chauffeur ~~permit~~ endorsement holder is suspended by the Department, the chauffeur permit will not be valid while the Georgia driver's license is under suspension, revocation, or cancellation.

**SYNOPSIS**

**STATEMENT OF PURPOSE AND MAIN FEATURES OF PROPOSED RULE**

The purpose of this proposed amendment is to modify the existing rule to conform to the changes resulting from the enactment of House Bill 865 during the 2012 Session of the Georgia General Assembly.

**DIFFERENCES BETWEEN EXISTING AND PROPOSED RULES**

All references to a chauffeur's permit were changed to an endorsement.

Paragraph (4) was expanded to reflect that other withdrawals of the customer's driving privilege could negatively impact his or her eligibility for a chauffeur's endorsement.
