Directions to the Georgia Public Safety Training Center

From Atlanta, take I-75 South to Exit 188. After exiting, turn right on Goodwyne Road. You will see the signs for GPSTC. Cross the railroad tracks onto Indian Springs Drive. The entrance to GPSTC will be straight ahead.

From the Macon area, take I-75 North to Exit 188. After exiting, turn right. Stay straight until you reach the stop sign. Turn right on Goodwyne Road. You will see the signs for GPSTC. Cross the railroad tracks onto Indian Springs Drive. The entrance to GPSTC will be straight ahead.

We will plan to have an hour long lunch break. Lunch will not be provided; however, there is a cafeteria inside of the training center and several restaurants are within 5 miles of the GPSTC campus.
