Synopsis

Statement of Purpose and Main Features of the Proposed Rule

The purpose of this proposed rule is to shorten the retest period for failures on CDL tests. The shorter period of two (2) days is consistent with the minimum time frame required by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration for Third Party Testers to notify the state of scheduled road tests.

DIFFERENCE BETWEEN EXISTING AND PROPOSED RULE

The current rule provides that any applicant who fails the examination may re-attempt the examination one (1) day after the first failure and seven (7) days after the second or subsequent failures. This amendment will change the retest period to two (2) days.
