

375-3-1-.31 Satisfaction of School Requirements for Customers Under Age Eighteen (18)

(1) Any customer under age eighteen (18) who is applying for a driver's license or instructional permit shall provide satisfactory documentation of his or her enrollment; ~~attendance and good behavior~~ in school. Documents that will satisfy this requirement include, but are not limited to, the following:

~~(a) Form DS-1,~~

(a) Form DS-1, Certificate of School Enrollment ~~(b) Form DS-3, or~~ and;

~~(b)(e)~~ A transcript provided by the customer's most recent school of attendance.

(2) Customers under age eighteen (18) who are schooled at home may satisfy the school requirements of O.C.G.A. §40-5-22 by supplying a Certificate of ~~Enrollment~~ Attendance from the Georgia Department of Education or a Declaration of Intent To Utilize a Home Study Program filed with the Georgia Department of Education.

SYNOPSIS

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE AND MAIN FEATURES OF PROPOSED RULE

The purpose of this proposed amendment is to incorporate statutory changes resulting from the enactment of Senate Bill 100, Sections 3-1, 3-2, and 4-8, during the 2015 Session of the Georgia General Assembly.

DIFFERENCES BETWEEN EXISTING AND PROPOSED RULES

Code Section (1) the language "attendance and good behavior," have been removed, as this portion of the law has been repealed.

Code Section (1)(a) has been replaced with the language "Certificate of School Enrollment.

Code Section (1) now contains sections (a) and (b).

Code Section (2) the word "Attendance," has been replaced with the word "Enrollment."
