

375-3-8-.02 Access to driver history record information for State Agencies, Municipalities, Counties, and Public Boards of Education for Employment Purposes.

A state agency, municipal government, county government, or school board of a municipality or county may apply for and obtain access to driver history record information regarding any employee or applicant for employment who has given written consent for such access. Access shall be obtained by submitting a request to, and subject to approval by, the Department of ~~Motor Vehicle Safety~~ Driver Services and in accordance with a contract with the Georgia Technology Authority for such access. No fee shall be charged to the agency or department if the record is accessed electronically.
